

## Machingo Madness: Championship VGD Tournament

Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025 Registration 4:00 pm to 6:30 pm, Tournament Start 6:45 pm

## **How to Gain Entry:**

- 1. To gain entry into the Machingo Madness Championship VGD Tournament, participants must have won a hot seat drawing during the qualifying days (3/16/2025, 3/20/2025, 3/23/2025, 3/27/2025, 3/30/2025, 4/5/2025) and present their valid ID at the registration area on 4/7/2025 before the tournament's first round begins, starting at 4 pm and ending at 6:45 pm.
- 2. Additionally, Muckleshoot Bingo will extend invitations to top players of its Player Tracking System/Loyalty Database who meet specific criteria. These pre-selected guests must present their valid ID at the registration area on 4/7/2025 before the tournament's first round begins, starting at 4 pm and ending at 6:45 pm.
- 3. Championship VGD Tournament invitations cannot be transferred to another person and have no cash value.
- 4. This tournament is free and comes at no cost to the qualifying participants.
- 5. Qualifiers may only participate in one (1) tournament round (unless advancing to the final round).
- 6. Only one invite/entry per person; multiple entries will not be allowed.
- 7. All qualified participants will also receive (1) ticket valid for a meal during the event and (1) drawing ticket for a chance to win a Door Prize. Participants' meal and drawing tickets cannot be transferred to another person.

<u>Entry Exclusions:</u> Muckleshoot Bingo (MIB) Employees are NOT eligible to win or participate in this Championship VGD Tournament.

#### **How to Be Selected/Win:**

- 1. The first round will begin at 6:45 pm with an additional final round to follow.
- 2. There will be a maximum of 11 sessions with 12 players in each session for the first round.
- 3. Once the first sessions have been completed, the top 10 scores from all sessions combined will advance to the final round.
- 4. The final 10 winners from the final round will be awarded a cash prize (see Pay Table section) based on the order of top scores.
- 5. In the event of a Tie score, the winners will face off in an additional playoff round to see who remains in that position. The loser of the tie will fall one place below.
- 6. Each session will be one (1) minute in length of VGD TournEvent play.
- 7. All participants' scores from the tournament are originated by the TournEvent system from highest score to lowest score.
- 8. All scores will be kept and tallied by the TournEvent system.
- 9. Registered participants who fail to show at the time of play will be given a 2-minute warning announced on the in-house PA system. If the player fails to show after the 2-minute warning, the round will begin without that player.

10. If a participant fails to show up for the final round after the 2-minute warning, the player with the next highest score will take their place, which will continue until a player is found or 10 minutes have passed.

## Door Prize Drawings:

- 1. Participants must place their drawing ticket into the physical drawing drum located near the tournament area before 8 pm on 4/7/2025.
- 2. After the final tournament round, MIB will randomly select a drawing ticket from the drawing drum to award a door prize (see Door Prize Pay Table).
- 3. Participants must be present to win.
- 4. MIB will announce the winning raffle ticket number, and the person with the winning raffle ticket number will have one (1) minute to identify themselves and report to the tournament area.
- 5. If the person with the winning raffle ticket number does not identify themselves or report to the tournament area within one (1) minute, another winning raffle ticket number will be selected.
- 6. After each drawing, the winning raffle ticket will be removed from the drawing bin and will no longer be eligible to win again.
- 7. Participants may win multiple door prizes.

#### **General Rules:**

- 1. The Muckleshoot Indian Tribe, any other contest sponsor, and their affiliated entities and their respective officers and employees shall be released and discharged from any and all claims, losses, injuries, demands, or actions which arise out of or are in any way related to the prize(s), the receipt, use or enjoyment of prize(s), or damages or losses related to the contest.
- 2. The Tribe reserves the right to postpone, suspend, or terminate the promotion or amend the rules at any time without notice to participants.
- 3. By entering or participating in the promotion, participants grant Muckleshoot Indian Tribe and its affiliated entities the right to use their names, likeness, or voice for promotional purposes without further compensation or permission.
- 4. Prizes may not be traded or transferred. Substitution of cash, or equivalent for noncash prizes unless expressly stated in the contest rules is not permitted, provided that, in the event that the Tribe at its sole discretion reserves the right to substitute cash in the event that a noncash prize becomes unavailable. In accepting a prize, the winner accepts the prize "as is" with no warranties.

- 5. Winners of promotional contests will be required to present valid photo identification acceptable to the Tribe, social security number, and complete an IRS Form W-9 and a winner release form before a promotional contest prize will be awarded. Failure to provide required identification and complete required IRS Form W-9 and a winner release may result in forfeiture of promotional contest prizes.
- 6. Participants acknowledge that Prizes may be subject to tax withholding under applicable federal regulations and that payouts may be reduced due to withholding requirements. Winners agree to pay all expenses, taxes and fees not included in the prize. The Tribe will report winnings in excess of \$600 in cash or fair market value during a calendar year to the IRS, and such winners will receive an IRS Form 1099.
- 7. For promotional contests that require physical participation, selected participants who are physically unable to participate may designate a person other than an employee of Muckleshoot Casino or Bingo to participate on their behalf.
- 8. Participants are responsible for hearing contest announcements and the Tribe shall not be responsible in any manner for the failure of a participant to hear or respond to contest announcements. In promotional contests involving a drawing, in case of public address system failure, the drawing may continue, and in such event, the selected participant's name will be announced without amplification at the drawing location.
- 9. The Tribe is not responsible for lost or stolen entries, or coupons, computer malfunctions or other incidents resulting in loss of entries.
- 10. The Tribe is not responsible for the inability to enter a drawing due to long lines or other causes.
- 11. Muckleshoot Bingo (MIB) Employees who are eligible to play bingo or VGD machines as outlined in the personnel policies are eligible to play during the promotional timeframe; however, MIB Employees are NOT eligible to participate and win in VGD tournaments, drawings of any kind, giveaways, Hot Seat promotions, Free Play promotions, and select discount and coupon offers. - 12. Entries are not transferable.
- 13. Violation of contest rules may result in disqualification.
- 14. Muckleshoot Bingo house rules apply.
