

Juneteenth "Freedom Day" Free Play Bingo Hot Seats | All Sessions

Thursday, June 19, 2025

OFFICIAL RULES

How to Gain Entry:

- 1. Participants must be 18 years of age or older and have a Muckleshoot Bingo Players Club card.
- 2. On Thursday, June 19, 2025, during the Matinee Session (beginning at 11:40 AM), Evening Session (beginning at 6:40 PM) and the Late Night Session (beginning at 11 PM), all participants must purchase a 9-on or an electronic package deal from admissions using their Muckleshoot Bingo Players Club card for the session.
- 3. During each session, all participants who have bought in for that session will be eligible to win one of six hot seat drawings for cash and free play.
- 4. All participants who have bought in for the session will also be eligible to win an extra \$619 in cash if they are a single winner who bingos on I-19.

<u>Entry Exclusions:</u> Muckleshoot Bingo (MIB) employees are allowed to play bingo during the promotion, but they are NOT allowed to win a Hot Seat prize.

How to Play / Win

- 1. Throughout each session, Muckleshoot Bingo will randomly select six (6) Hot Seat prize winners using the random Player Draw function in the Live Bingo Management System to win a prize (see Pay Table section for prizes).
- 2. Muckleshoot Bingo will announce the winning names over the PA system throughout each session. Winners will have two (2) minutes to identify themselves to a Live Bingo floor employee or report directly to the caller stand to receive their Hot Seat prize.
- 3. Participants are only eligible to win one (1) hot seat per session.
- 4. Single winners who bingo on I-19 will receive \$619 cash in addition to the regular game payout. Multiple winners who bingo using I-19 during the same game will split \$619 evenly in addition to splitting the regular game payout evenly.
- 5. Participants are eligible to win on I-19 multiple times during the session.

Pay Table

- 1. Single bingo winners on I-19 pays \$619 cash during each session. Total depends on the number of participants who bingo on I-19 during each session.
- 2. During each session, the following hot seat prizes will be awarded to eligible participants:
 - Hot Seat #1 (1) \$50 Cash
 - Hot Seat #2 (1) \$50 Cash
 - Hot Seat #3 (1) \$50 Bingo Free Play
 - Hot Seat #4 (1) \$50 Bingo Free Play
 - Hot Seat #5 (1) \$50 VGD Free Play
 - Hot Seat #6 (1) \$50 VGD Free Play
 - Session total: (6) drawings \$300 in Cash and Free Play
 - Daily total: (18) drawings = \$900 in Cash and Free Play.

General Rules:

- 1. The Muckleshoot Indian Tribe, any other contest sponsor, and their affiliated entities and their respective officers and employees shall be released and discharged from any and all claims, losses, injuries, demands, or actions which arise out of or are in any way related to the prize(s), the receipt, use or enjoyment of prize(s), or damages or losses related to the contest.
- 2. The Tribe reserves the right to postpone, suspend, or terminate the promotion or amend the rules at any time without notice to participants.
- 3. By entering or participating in the promotion, participants grant Muckleshoot Indian Tribe and its affiliated entities the right to use their names, likeness, or voice for promotional purposes without further compensation or permission.
- 4. Prizes may not be traded or transferred. Substitution of cash, or equivalent for noncash prizes unless expressly stated in the contest rules is not permitted, provided that, in the event that the Tribe at its sole discretion reserves the right to substitute cash in the event that a noncash prize becomes unavailable. In accepting a prize, the winner accepts the prize "as is" with no warranties
- 5. Winners of promotional contests will be required to present valid photo identification acceptable to the Tribe, social security number, and complete an IRS Form W-9 and a winner release form before a promotional contest prize will be awarded. Failure to provide required identification and complete required IRS Form W-9 and a winner release may result in forfeiture of promotional contest prizes.
- 6. Participants acknowledge that Prizes may be subject to tax withholding requirements under applicable federal regulations and that payouts may be reduced due to withholding requirements. Winners agree to pay all expenses, taxes and fees not included in the prize. The Tribe will report winnings in excess of\$600 in cash or fair market value during a calendar year to the IRS and such winners will receive and IRS Form 1099.
- 7. For promotional contests that require physical participation, selected participants who are physically unable to participate may designate a person other than an employee of Muckleshoot Casino or Bingo to participate on their behalf.
- 8. Participants are responsible for hearing contest announcements and the Tribe shall not be responsible in any manner for the failure of a participant to hear or respond to contest announcements. In promotional contests involving a drawing, in case of public address system failure the drawing may continue and in such event the selected participant's name will be announced without amplification at the drawing location.
- 9. The Tribe is not responsible for lost or stolen entries, or coupons, computer malfunctions or other incidents resulting in loss of entries.
- 10. The Tribe is not responsible for inability to enter a drawing due to long lines or other causes.
- 11. Muckleshoot Bingo (MIB) Employees who are eligible to play bingo or VGD machines as outlined in the personnel policies are eligible to play during the promotional timeframe; however, MIB Employees are NOT eligible to participate and win in VGD tournaments, drawings of any kind, giveaways, Hot Seat promotions, Free Play promotions, and select discount and coupon offers. Always check the How to Gain Entry/Win sections of the official rules for specific exclusion information.
- 12. Entries are not transferable.
- 13. Violation of contest rules may result in disqualification.
- 14. Muckleshoot Bingo house rules apply.
- 15. Any guest dissatisfied with a decision/ruling in this promotion may, within thirty (30) days of the disputed decision/ruling, submit their complaint in the form of a written petition for relief to the Muckleshoot Gaming Commission.
