OFFICIAL RULES

How to Gain Entry:

1. Participants must be 18 years of age or older and have an active Muckleshoot Bingo Players Club account.
2. Participants will receive one (1) drawing ticket per person, per session, when they buy-in for the 41st Anniversary Backyard BBQ Bingo session at the Admissions window.
3. Each drawing ticket will include the participant's name, Players Club card number, and the session name for which the ticket is valid.
4. Drawing tickets are non-transferable, have no cash value, and will not be replaced if lost, stolen, or damaged.

Entry Exclusions: *Muckleshoot Bingo (MIB) employees are not allowed to participate in the session or the drawings.*

How to Play/Win:

1. Participants must be present to win.
2. Participants must place their drawing ticket into the physical drawing drum located at the Gift Table before 6 pm on Saturday, June 6th, 2026.
3. During the main bingo session, Muckleshoot Bingo will draw ten (10) random drawing tickets from the drawing drum and announce the winning names over the PA system.
4. Winners will have two (2) minutes to identify themselves to a Live Bingo floor employee or report directly to the caller stand to claim their prize (see Pay Table below).
5. If the winner does not identify themselves within the two (2) minutes, Muckleshoot Bingo will draw another ticket. This same process will occur until a winner has been verified.
6. Once a drawing ticket has been drawn and the winner verified, the ticket will be removed from the session's drawing drum. Upon completion of the session, all remaining tickets in the drum will be discarded.
7. Participants may only win one (1) drawing per session.

Entry Exclusions: *Muckleshoot Bingo Employees are NOT allowed to play during this session or receive a free meal or gift.*
