OFFICIAL RULES

How to Gain Entry:

1. Participants must be at least 18 years of age and have a Muckleshoot Bingo Players Club account.
2. To gain entry into the Summer Send Off Free Machine Tournament, participants must register in person on Sunday, September 6, 2026, from 3:30 pm to 5:15 pm in order to play.
3. The registration area will be located near the escalator to the second floor.

Entry Exclusions: *Muckleshoot Bingo (MIB) Employees are NOT eligible to win or participate in this promotion.*

How to Play/Win:

1. Participants must be present to win.
2. The first round of sessions will begin at 5:30 pm inside the TournEvent area in Game Room 5, with an additional final round to follow.
3. Session placement and start times will be assigned by MIB during the registration period based on participants' arrival times. Sessions will be filled sequentially on a first-come, first-served basis.
4. Participants' seating assignment during their session will be determined by the Multimedia TournEvent system. Participants will find their name located at the top of the tournament gaming machine.
5. Each session, including the second and final round session, will be two (2) minutes in length of VGD TournEvent play. The tournament play consists of players pressing the spin button on their machines as fast as they can and touching the machine screen that triggers bonus awards to generate the highest score.
6. All participants' scores from the tournament are generated by the TournEvent system, from highest to lowest.
7. All scores will be kept and tallied by the TournEvent system.
8. Registered participants who fail to arrive after two minutes of their scheduled start time will forfeit their seat in the tournament.
9. Once the first round's sessions have been completed, the top 10 scores from all sessions combined will advance to the second and final round.
10. If a participant fails to show up for the final round after the 2-minute warning, the player with the next highest score will take their place, which will continue until a player is found or 10 minutes have passed.
11. The (10) winners from the final round will be awarded the prize listed in the Pay Table section based on the order of their final round score.
12. In the event of a tie score, the winners will face off in an additional playoff round to see who remains in that position. The loser of the tie will fall one place below.
13. If a machine malfunction, system outage, communication failure, power interruption, software error, or other technical issue impacts tournament play, Muckleshoot Bingo may pause, modify, restart, reschedule, or cancel all or part of the tournament as necessary to maintain a fair and equitable competition. Previously recorded scores, rankings, standings, or results may be adjusted, cleared, or reset if deemed necessary to ensure fairness to all participants. Tournament management will

determine the appropriate resolution based on the circumstances, subject to applicable Tribal Gaming Agency requirements. All decisions regarding tournament play, scoring, advancement, prize awards, and tournament outcomes made by Muckleshoot Bingo Management shall be final.

Pay Tables:

1. Participants with the top ten (10) scores of the tournament will receive the following.

- 1st Place: \$3,000 Cash
- 2nd Place: \$2,000 Cash
- 3rd Place: \$1,000 Cash
- 4th Place: \$800 Free VGD Play
- 5th Place: \$700 Free VGD Play
- 6th Place: \$600 Free VGD Play
- 7th Place: \$500 Free VGD Play
- 8th Place: \$400 Free VGD Play
- 9th Place: \$300 Free VGD Play
- 10th Place: \$200 Free VGD Play

Maximum Available Daily Prize Pool: \$6,000 Cash + \$3,500 Free Play = \$9,500 in Cash and Free VGD Play

General Rules:

1. All participants must show their Muckleshoot Bingo Players Club card and valid photo identification to be verified as a prize winner.
2. The Muckleshoot Indian Tribe (Tribe), any other contest sponsor, and their affiliated entities and their respective officers and employees shall be released and discharged from any and all claims, losses, injuries, demands, or actions which arise out of or are in any way related to the prize(s), the receipt, use or enjoyment of prize(s), or damages or losses related to the contest.
3. The Tribe reserves the right to postpone, suspend, or terminate the promotion or amend the rules at any time without notice to participants.
4. By entering or participating in the promotion, participants grant Muckleshoot Indian Tribe and its affiliated entities the right to use their names, likenesses, or voices for promotional purposes without further compensation or permission.
5. Barred and suspended patrons are not allowed to win any promotional prize and will automatically forfeit any prize.
6. Entries and prizes may not be traded or transferred. Substitution of cash, or equivalent for noncash prizes - unless expressly stated in the contest rules - is not permitted; however, the Tribe at its sole discretion reserves the right to substitute cash in the event that a noncash prize becomes unavailable. In accepting a prize, the winner accepts the prize "as is" with no warranties.
7. Players who win free play, non-cash prizes, or cash prizes under \$100 will not be required to provide a Social Security card or complete an IRS Form W-9. For promotional contest prizes of \$100 or more, players must present valid government-issued photo identification and either provide a copy of their Social Security card or complete an IRS Form W-9. Failure to provide the required documentation may result in forfeiture of the prize. Muckleshoot Indian Bingo may also request the player to complete a winner release form.
8. Participants acknowledge that prizes may be subject to tax withholding requirements under applicable federal regulations and that payouts may be reduced due to withholding requirements. Winners agree to pay all expenses, taxes, and fees not included in the prize. The Tribe will report winnings in excess of \$600 in cash or fair market value during a calendar year to the IRS, and such winners will receive an IRS Form 1099.
9. For promotional contests that require physical participation, selected participants who are physically unable to participate may designate a person other than an employee of Muckleshoot Casino or Bingo to participate on their behalf.
10. Participants are responsible for hearing contest announcements, and the Tribe shall not be responsible in any manner for the failure of a participant to hear or respond to contest announcements. In promotional contests involving a drawing, in the event of a public address system failure, the drawing may continue. In such an event,

the selected participant's name will be announced without amplification at the drawing location.

11. The Tribe is not responsible for lost or stolen entries, coupons, computer malfunctions, or other incidents that result in the loss of entries or prizes.
12. The Tribe is not responsible for the inability to enter a drawing due to long lines or other causes.
13. Muckleshoot Bingo (MIB) Employees who are eligible to play bingo or VGD machines as outlined in the personnel policies are eligible to play during the promotional timeframe; however, MIB Employees are NOT eligible to win VGD tournaments, drawings of any kind, giveaways, Hot Seat promotions, Free Play promotions, and select discount and coupon offers. 14. Violation of contest rules may result in disqualification.
15. Muckleshoot Bingo house rules apply.
16. Any guest dissatisfied with a decision/ruling in this promotion may, within thirty (30) days of the disputed decision/ruling, submit their complaint in the form of a written petition for relief to the Muckleshoot Gaming Commission.
